

Rental Rates and Conditions

Rental Rates

Precise Facility Rental Rates are available upon request. All rental rates refer to the rental of the building and do not include the cost of labor, equipment, or other costs related to the event not explicitly stated otherwise. Although a precise rate is available upon request, general rates are as follows:

\$5,000 per event day vs. 10% of adjusted Gross Ticket Sales for ticketed events.

Move In/Move Out days: Calculated at 50% of the daily rental rate.

Booking Procedures

Prospective tenants must contact the General Manager to determine the availability of dates. Tim's Toyota Center will tentatively reserve requested dates after completion of the license application by the tenant and acceptance by Tim's Toyota Center. A date is not considered firm until a signed contract and required deposit are returned to the building. The General Manager of the Arena may deny the use of the facility to any individual, group, organization, or event that would result in an unfair degree of competition or is not in the best interest of Tim's Toyota Center. If another tenant should request the dates in question or a portion thereof, the tenant will be required to execute a contractual agreement and submit the required deposit within 24 hours of notification or within a time as specified by the General Manager. If the contract and deposit are not received, the General Manager will release the dates without notice.

Deposit Requirements and Procedures

A deposit is required as consideration in order to secure a date at the Arena. If less than thirty days prior to the event an initial deposit of 100% of the base rent is required upon signing of contract. For events with assigned dates less than one year and more than thirty days prior to the event, a 50% deposit is due upon signing the contract. Tim's Toyota Center management reserves the right to require an additional sum in advance to cover estimated expenses and/or as damage deposit which is refundable after the event is settled and when a check of the facility is completed.

Statement and Payment Policy

All charges due Tim's Toyota Center are payable on demand. Any balances over thirty days will be charged a two percent monthly finance charge until payment is received. Tim's Toyota Center will pay net proceeds due from ticket receipts less rent and other charges in a timely manner after the conclusion of the event.

Settlement

Tim's Toyota Center will produce a Box Office statement and settlement of all monies owed upon closing the Box Office for the final performance.

Liability Insurance

Tenant shall obtain, at its own cost and expense, commercial general liability insurance in the name of Licensee which shall insure all operations of Licensee. Such insurance shall be written with a limit of at least One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage liability, personal injury liability and coverage for all acts and/or omissions of any employees, agents, players, performers, contractors or sub-contracts retained by Licensee. Such insurance shall be endorsed to be primary to and not contributory with any coverage of Tim's Toyota Center, the Town of Prescott Valley, International Coliseums Company, and the Fain Signature Group (collectively, the "tenant related parties") which may be applicable to the claim.

Tenant shall maintain, at its own cost and expense, Workman's Compensation Insurance in respect of its players, performers and other employees whose services are contemplated by the event. Tenant must maintain Employer's Liability Insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000 per accident. Tenant shall also maintain Automobile Liability Insurance with limits not less than \$500,000 for each occurrence, combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage including coverage for owned, non-owned and hired vehicles, including loading and unloading operations. Certificates evidencing insurance must be provided not less than ten (10) days prior to the event.

Event Requirements and Staffing

Tim's Toyota Center will provide and the lessee will be charged for all event-related staffing. This personnel includes full box office services, ticket sellers, ticket takers, ushers, stagehands, security, technical lighting, sound and audio/visual personnel, custodians, forklift operators, and the like. Tenants are instructed not to make any other staffing arrangement for their events at Tim's Toyota Center without first obtaining written permission from the General Manager. Tim's Toyota Center requires general event staff and security for the building and perimeter.

Food and Beverage

Tim's Toyota Center has exclusivity over all food and beverages served and consumed throughout the facility. The tenant, exhibitors, or their representatives may not sell food and beverage items at any time. Food and beverages may not be brought onto the premises of Tim's Toyota Center by exhibitors for the purpose of distribution to patrons without the expressed written permission of the General Manager. Patrons may not bring food and beverages onto the premises of Tim's Toyota Center at any time. In accordance with the rules and regulations of the State of Arizona, it is against the law for a tenant, exhibitor, or patron to bring alcoholic beverages into the building for any purpose. All arrangements for alcoholic beverages must be made through Tim's Toyota Center. Under no circumstances will alcoholic beverages purchased or distributed by a tenant, exhibitor, or patron be permitted to be taken off the premises of Tim's Toyota Center.

Catering

Tim's Toyota Center has exclusivity over all catering services provided on the premises. All catering will be provided by the Arena's food and beverage department. The Arena has the capacity to seat approximately 1,000 people for a catered function within the facility. Arrangements for catered functions are made through the Arena.

Marketing Services

Tim's Toyota Center "In-House" agency can assist you with numerous details involved to successfully market your event. Our agency can provide for the production and placement of print and electronic advertising for a negotiated fee (based on time, labor, and expenses). Tim's Toyota Center can also assist with promotions, public relations and publicity needed to ensure ticket sales. Our Group Sales Department would be happy to implement a group sales program for your event, at a low commission rate of only 10% of the overall group dollars (plus reimbursement of direct expenses).

The Tim's Toyota Center logo must be used in all materials used to promote events. The logo must be displayed at the bottom of newspaper ads, brochures, billboards, etc.

Forklifts

Tim's Toyota Center owns one 5,000 lb. forklift, with a lift height of 17 ft. and a fork length of 6 ft. The forklift is propane fueled.

Staging

Tim's Toyota Center owns a state-of-the-art staging system with a maximum size of 60x40 sq. ft. with portable risers extracted.

Square Footage

Total site (including all levels) is 134,800 sq. ft.

The Center Floor is 17,000 sq. ft. with dasher board configuration.

Seating

There are four retractable rows on either side of the bowl and fourteen retractable rows at the East end. Tim's Toyota Center has the ability to remove the retractable seats at the East end in order to provide a bigger elephant door entrance. The total number of retractable seats is 1,094.

Rigging

Total rigging weight for end stage configuration is 100,000 lbs. Rigging plans are available from the Operations Office. All rigging plans, including the weight of each point must be submitted to and approved by Management prior to load in. The grid trusses are on 28 ft. centers upstage to back of house.

Loading Dock

The facility has two sunken loading docks with dock plates that allow a level run from truck to performance area. There is a mild ramp area from outside directly to the back roll-up door. The dock can accommodate two trucks. There are five (5) shore service outlets.

Elevators

Two elevators: 1 service/passenger and 1 passenger.

Emergency Equipment

Fire sprinklers, smoke sensors and fire extinguishers are located throughout the facility. The facility employs an emergency generator for life safety light and sound only.

Locks and Keys

Locker/dressing rooms may be secured with locks and keys. Keys for each room may be checked out through the Operations Office. All persons who sign out keys will be responsible for return of the keys at the conclusion of the event.

Pyrotechnics

A permit is required for any pyrotechnics used in the building or anywhere on the premises. There will be a designated room used for storing pyrotechnics. Building will supply fire extinguishers at the shows' expense. A permit must be obtained from the City and a demonstration held prior to the event.

Features for Patrons with Disabilities

All entrances to the suite level of Tim's Toyota Center are wheelchair accessible. Designated disabled parking is conveniently located at the main entrance. Elevators are available inside Tim's Toyota Center to provide access between levels. Disabled seating is available at various locations inside the bowl.

Television/Video System

Tim's Toyota Center is equipped with an in-house TV/video system that includes two video boards and three portable cameras.

Labor and Service Rates

All rates are hourly and there is a four-hour minimum on all hourly staff. Additional minimums may be required based on specific contracts. All rates are subject to change.
